Rules & Regulations

1. The organisers shall not be held liable for any claim in respect of theft, damage or accident to any person, animal or vehicle.
2. No dogs will be permitted on the show ground unless on a lead.
3. The judges decision will be final. Objections can be made in writing with the objectors full name and address and must be lodged at the secretary's office within an hour of the event taking place together with a £10 deposit. The deposit shall be returned if the objection is sustained.
4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to alter or cancel a class if necessary.
5. The judges named in the schedule have accepted the invitation to judge but the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge unable to attend.
6. Anyone riding a horse/pony at this show must wear a hard hat and those competing in any S.J. XC. or Working Hunter class must wear an approved BSI Standard or European Standard jockey skull cap in the jumping phase. Skullcaps must have a navy blue or black cover.
7. The committee reserve the right to amalgamate & reduce the prize money if there is a lack of entries in any classes.
8. Classes will start at their stated times / approximated times.
9. Entry fees are not refundable unless accompanied by a vet's certificate.
10. It is the responsibility of the recipient to insure the Trophy. It must be returned in a clean state. Trophies will be on display in the secretary's office during the day. Successful exhibitors may collect the trophy they have won from the secretary on producing the Trophy Card and signing for by an adult. The committee cannot be responsible for forwarding trophies to exhibitors after the show; they will be put into storage until the following year.
11. Whilst every possible care is taken towards helping competitors compete in different classes during the day, it is not always possible to prevent classes from coinciding with each other.
12. Horses and Ponies can only be tied to their vehicle for tacking up or untacking purposes and must not be left unattended.
13. Drivers must park their Vehicles as directed by the Stewards.

PONIES

- Class 9 **Open Working Hunter Pony**
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 13hh (133cm) rider not to attained 14th birthday
- Class 10 **Open Working Hunter Pony**
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 13hh (133cm) not exceeding 14hh (143cm) rider not to attained 17th birthday
- Class 11 **Open Working Hunter Pony**
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) not exceeding 15hh (153cm) rider not to attained 20th birthday
- Class 11a **Working Hunter Pony Championship**
For 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 9-11. The champion will receive a challenge cup.

HORSES

- Class 12 **Novice Working Hunter**
Open to horses 4yrs or over, exceeding 14.2hh (148cm). Rider any age. No fence will exceed 2'9".
- Class 13 **Open Working Hunter**
Open to horses 4yrs or over, exceeding 14.2hh (148cm). Rider any age. No fence will exceed 3'3".
- Class 13a **Working Hunter Championship**
For 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 12 & 13. The champion will receive a challenge cup.
